



We hereby certify that we have surveyed and staked, Omaha, Nebraska, January 27th, 1914, a tract of land described as follows: Beginning at the intersection of the North line of Sherman Avenue and the East right-of-way line of the C.S.P.R.R. Ry. and running parallel thereto South along the North Range Line of Section 13 East of the G.M. & O. Ry. Douglas County, Nebraska, thence West along the North Range Line, then North along the South boundary line of Section 13, thence West along the C.S.P.R.R. Ry. 2200 feet, more or less, to the intersection of the said right-of-way line with the East and West right-of-way line of Sherman Avenue, thence East along Sherman Avenue, 13 feet, more or less, to the corner on the West line of Sherman Avenue, or 14th Street, 33 feet West of the Southeast corner of the North 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 13, thence South, being a subdivision of that part of the Southwest 1/4 of Section 13, lying South of the City Limit line of Omaha, Nebraska, and within the Easterly right-of-way line of the C.S.P.R.R.
