SPECIAL PERMIT NO. 1291

WHEREAS, Ross Engineering has submitted an application designated as Special Permit No. 1291 for authority to construct elderly housing on property located on the southeast corner of 70th Street and Shamrock Road, and legally described to wit:

The north 175 feet of the west 322.79 feet of Lot 5 and the south 25 feet of the west 322.79 feet of Lot 4, Strain's Acres, Lincoln, Lancaster County, Nebraska, except that portion deeded to the City of Lincoln by the instrument filed February 10, 1986, as Instrument No. 86-3408; and

The west 322.79 feet of the south 188.55 feet of Lot 5, Strain's Acres, Lincoln, Lancaster County, Nebraska, except that part deeded to the City of Lincoln by the instrument filed February 18, 1986, as Instrument No. 86-3894.

WHEREAS, the real property adjacent to the area included within the plot plan for this elderly housing project will not be adversely affected; and

WHEREAS, said plot plan together with the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth are consistent with the intent and purpose of Title 27 of the Lincoln Municipal Code to promote the public health, safety, morals, and general welfare.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Lincoln, Nebraska:

That the application of Ross Engineering, hereinafter referred to as "Permittee", to construct elderly housing be and the same is hereby granted under the provisions of Section 27.63.210 of the Lincoln Municipal Code upon condition that construction and operation of said elderly housing project be in strict compliance with said application, the plot plan, and the following additional express terms, conditions, and requirements:

- 1. This permit approves a maximum of 51 units. All units shall comply with Section 2.A of the design standards for density bonuses. At least 6 units shall comply with both Sections 2.A and 2.B of the design standards for density bonuses.
 - 2. Change of Zone 2405 must receive approval.
 - 3. Before receiving building permits:
 - a. A landscape plan must be approved by the Planning Director.
 - b. The construction plans shall comply with the approved plans and all applicable ordinances of the City.

- 4. Before occupying this building, all development and construction shall comply with the approved plans.
- 5. All privately-owned improvements, including landscaping, shall be permanently maintained by the owner.
- 6. The permittee shall annually certify that all occupied dwelling units, except units designated for occupancy by the handicapped, are occupied by at least one individual 60 years of age or older.
- 7. The terms, conditions, and requirements of this resolution shall be binding and obligatory upon the Permittee, successors, and assigns. The building official shall report violations to the City Council which may revoke the special permit or take such other action as may be necessary to gain compliance.
- 8. The Permittee shall sign and return the City's letter of acceptance to the City Clerk within 30 days following approval of the special permit, provided, however, said 30-day period may be extended up to six months by administrative amendment. The City Clerk shall file a copy of the resolution approving the special permit and the letter of acceptance with the Register of Deeds, filing fees therefor to be paid in advance by the Permittee.
