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AN ORDINANCE declaring Grover Street from the alley West of 41st Street to 42nd Street in The City of Omaha widened and opened to public travel.

WHEREAS it has been duly declared necessary by Ordinance No. 14644 to appropriate certain lands and real estate for the use of The City of Omaha for opening and widening Grover Street; and,

WHEREAS three disinterested freeholders of the City, after being duly sworn to perform the duties of their appointment with fidelity and impartiality, have assessed the damages to the owners of the property taken by such appropriation; and,

WHEREAS such assessment has been duly reported to the City Council for confirmation and has been duly approved and confirmed; and,

WHEREAS all other requirements of law relating to the appropriation of private property for the use of the City for the purpose aforesaid have been complied with.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OMAHA,

Section 1. That Grover Street from the alley West of 41st Street to 42nd Street be, and the same hereby is, declared widened and opened to public travel under such restrictions and regulations as the City Council may from time to time prescribe and to be improved as may hereafter be ordered or required.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect fifteen days from and after its passage.
