Atchison and Nebraska P.R.

This agreement made this 15th day of February a.d. 1872 between Benjamin Horuley of the County of Gage and State of Nebraska of the first part and the Atchison and Nebraska Rail Road Company of the second part, Witnesseth. That for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar, ^{and} that said Company shall construct a Rail road through the North West Quarter Section (36) Thirty Six Town Six (6) Range Eight (8) in Gage County State of Nebraska, the party of the first part, hereby gives, bargains and sells to said party of the second part the right of way for its Railroad on and over said tract of land to a width of fifty feet on each side from the center of the track of said road, as the same shall or may by said Company be located, for and during the term of the organization of said Company its heirs & assigns.
