CORRECTIVE QUIT CLAIM DEED

THIS INDENTURE, made this Aday of February, in the year one thousand nine hundred ninety between Mr. and/or Mrs. H. Wayne Smith, a/k/a Jeanette A. Smith and H. Wayne Smith, husband and wife, and Ronald N. Kaplan, a single person, as joint tenants as the Grantees in Quitclaim Deed at Book 1867 Page 217 and as the Grantors herein, and Ronald N. Kaplan, a single person, an undivided one-third interest, Grantee,

WITNESSETH, that the Grantors, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable consideration to them duly paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by Grantors, they have remised. released, and quit-claimed, and by these presents do remise, release and forever quit-claime unto the Grantee, and to his, her, or their heirs and assigns forever, all his, her or their right, title and interest, in and to an undivided one-third interest in all real property located at:

> The West 67.0 feet of the South 245.0 feet of Lot 15 and the South 95.0 feet of Lot 16 together with all of Lot 17, Old Mill Plaza, a subdivision as surveyed, platted, and recorded in Douglas County, Nebraska.
