as joint tenants with right of survivorship, and not as tenants in common, the following described real property in Cass

County, Nebraska: Lots 9 and 10 in North half of Southwest Quarter of Sec. 12, Township 11 N., Rge 13, E. of 6 P.M., also being described as South 330 ft. of North half of Southwest Quarter of said Section 12; also South half of Southwest Quarter of Section 12, Township 11 N., Rge 13, E. of 6 P.M. in Cass County, Nebr. excepting a tract described as: Commencing at a point 1,441 ft. east of Southwest corner of said Sec. 12, Township 11 N., Rge 13, E. of 6 P.M. and 728.4 ft. north of the south line of said Sec. 12, running thence east 157.06 ft. parallel to the south line, thence north 208 ft. to the point of beginning, subject also to an easement over and across the south half of said Southwest Quarter of said Sec. 12 for a driveway for access to the lot hereinbefore excepted, such easement to run with said tract in favor of the owners thereof, their heirs, successors & assigns, subject to all encumbrances and easements of record.

It is the intention of all parties hereto that in the event of the death of either of the grantees, the entire fee simple title to the real estate shall vest in the surviving grantee.
