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QUIT CLAIM DEED

THIS DEED, made and entered into by and between MISSOURI PACIFIC RAILROAD COMPANY, a Missouri corporation, herein called "Grantor", and SCOULAR-WELSH GRAIN COMPANY, a Nebraska corporation, herein called "Grantee", WITNESSETH:

That the Grantor, for and in consideration of TEN AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$10.00) and other good and valuable considerations, paid by Grantee to Grantor, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents REMISE, RELEASE and forever QUIT CLAIM unto the Grantee, its successors and assigns, subject to the reservations hereinafter stated, all of said Grantor's right, title and interest in and to the following described real property, including improvements located thereon, located in the City of Omaha, Douglas County, Nebraska, to-wit:

> A tract or parcel of land, being a part of Tax Lots 27, 29 and 39, located in the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 3, Township 15 North, Range 13 East of the 6th P.M., in Omaha, Douglas County, Nebraska, more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the Southwest corner of Tax Lot 27, said corner being the point of intersection of the East line of low but the East line of low but Pratt Street; thence eastwardly, along the South line of Tax Lot 27 and the North line of Pratt Street NEBRASKA DOCUMENTARY.

There is, however, expressly reserved unto Grantor, its successors and assigns the ownership of an existing radio antenna and appurtenant facilities situated atop the water tower located on the above described premises and an existing 6' x 8' metal radio base building and appurtenant facilities located on said premises, together with license to enter upon the above described premises to keep, operate, maintain, repair, renew and remove said antenna and metal building. The license hereby reserved shall remain in effect for so long as the Grantee, its successors and assigns shall have no specific need for that part of the above described premises occupied by said antenna and building. In the event there is such a specific need for said premises, Grantee, its successors and assigns shall serve

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Grantor, its successors and assigns written notice of such need and Grantor, its successors and assigns shall have 60 days from the date of such notice in which to remove the improvements hereby reserved.

There is, also, expressly reserved unto Grantor, its successors and assigns, the right to keep, own, use, maintain, repair, renew, alter, relocate, operate over and remove the existing railroad tracks, known as Grantor's tracks numbered 19-76, 19-77, 19-78, 19-79, 19-80 and 19-173, now located or partially located on the property described herein, and there is hereby reserved unto Grantor, its successors and assigns, easements for aforesaid railroad purposes, said easements encompassing all land described herein, except that now actually occupied by the grain elevator and appurtenant structures located on the premises. The rights and easements hereby reserved shall continue so long as the same shall be used or needed for railroad purposes. EXCEPTED from this track reservation is the 70.0-foot portion of Track No. 19-78 and the 82.2-foot portion of Track No. 19-77 located over and across the underground unloading pit situated on the west side of the elevator occupying a part of the premises, and the said 70.0-foot and 82.2-foot portions of these two (2) tracks are hereby conveyed to Grantee.

As a condition to and as a part of the consideration for this conveyance, and without which this conveyance would not have been made, Grantee agrees for itself, its successors and assigns that, in the event Grantee, its successors and assigns desire to alter existing or construct additional pipe lines, utilities or other facilities on, over under or across the tracks and easements herein reserved by Grantor, Grantee, its successors or assigns shall (i) prior to any such alterations and construction, notify and secure the approval of Grantor's General Manager at Kansas City, Missouri, (ii) cause any such alterations or construction to conform with the requirement of Grantor and any State, Federal or Municipal authority and (iii) indemnify and hold harmless the Grantor, its successors and assigns, from any liability, costs or expense in connection with any such alterations and construction.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all rights and appurtenances to the same belonging, unto Grantee, its successors and assigns forever.
