ORDINANCE NO. 221

An ordinance to vacate the west one-half of a public alley running east and west between Lots 261, 262 and 263 abutting on the north side of said alley and Lots 264, 265 and 266 abutting on the south side of said alley, all of said property located in the Original Town of Wilber, Saline County, Nebraska, reserving to the City of Wilber and its franchise holders certain easement rights in the vacated alley, and to provide for a time when this ordinance shall be in full force and effect.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILBER, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. Whereas, the owners of Lots 262, 263, 264, 265 and 266, and a part of Lot 261, in the Original Town of Wilber, Nebraska, have filed a petition asking that a public alley running east and west between the above-described lots and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at the southeast corner of said Lot 261, thence running west along the south boundary line of said Lots 261, 262 and 263 to the southwest corner of Lot 263, thence south a distance of twelve (12) feet to the northwest corner of said Lot 264, thence east along the north boundary of said Lots 264, 265 and 266, to the northeast corner of Lot 266, thence north a distance of twelve (12) feet to the place of be-

ginning: may be vacated, for the reason that said alley is not now and never has been used by the public, but has always been used as a part of a lumber yard, and, it being deemed advantageous and best for the interest of the city and said petitioners to vacate that part of the alley herein described, NOW, THEREFORE,

Section 2. The Alley more particularly described herein as commencing at the southeast corner of said Lot 261, thence running west along the south boundary line of said Lots 261, 262 and 263 to the southwest corner of Lot 263, thence south a distance of twelve (12) feet to the northwest corner of Lot 264, thence east along the north boundary of Lots 264, 265 and 266 to the northeast corner of Lot 266, thence north a distance of twelve (12) feet to the place of beginning, is hereby vacated and shall no longer be a public alley of the City of Wilber, Nebraska, and the area and territory included in said alley shall revert to the abutting properties according to law, the City of Wilber, however, reserving to itself and its franchise holders the right to place, keep in place and maintain upon said portion of said alley hereby vacated, electric and telephone lines and poles as may be in the public interest.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.

Passed and approved March 6th, 1962.

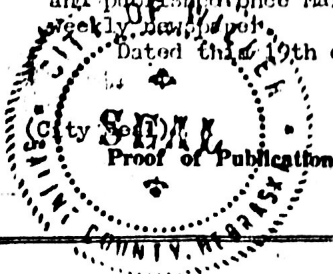
