

ORDINANCE NO. 3073

An Ordinance vacating that part of Thomas Avenue and Harry Avenue, in Rains First Addition to the City of Grand Island, Nebraska, extending from the south line of Roberts Avenue southward to the north line of the Chicago, Burlington & Quincy Railroad Company right of way and reserving title thereto in the City of Grand Island.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL of the City of Grand Island, Nebraska:

SECTION 1. That part of Thomas Avenue and that part of Harry Avenue in Rains First Addition to the City of Grand Island, Nebraska, extending from the south line of Roberts Avenue, southward to the north line of the Chicago, Burlington & Quincy Railroad Company right of way be, and the same is hereby vacated.

SECTION 2. That the title to that part of Thomas Avenue and Harry Avenue so vacated shall remain vested in the City of Grand Island, Nebraska.


SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall be in force and take effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.





