

Whitney, Edwin E. Alsworth and Esther V. Alsworth on February 3, 1978, granted to the National Cooperative Refinery Association the right to install, operate, maintain, repair and replace gate valves, gate valves and cathodic protection systems above described premises by written instrument recorded in Book 982, Page 66 in the office of the County Recorder of Williamson County, Iowa, and

whereas the National Cooperative Refinery Association desires to release its interest in said premises;

Now, therefore, in public consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the National Cooperative Refinery Association, a corporation, does hereby release the easement granted to it for the period 1978, annually, forever, re-ly and remove a five line, water main to improve and extend and stop the above described premises, except as to the following portion of said premises, to-wit:

A strip of ground 1 rod in width, the center line of which is described as follows: commencing at a point on the east line of the strip of the G-2 S-4, Section 12, Township 70 North, Range 44 West of the 5th P.M., 1888, 100 feet South of the center of said Section 12; thence North 62° 07' West 200.00 feet; thence North 60° 10' West 215 feet to the North line of said acre tract.

The National Cooperative Refinery Association hereby expressly retains all the rights granted to it under said written instrument as to such strip of ground one rod in width.

The National Cooperative Refinery Association hereby releases the gate valve permit and easement for cathodic unit site granted by written instrument recorded in Book 982 at Page 66.
