

## RELEASE OF EASEMENTS

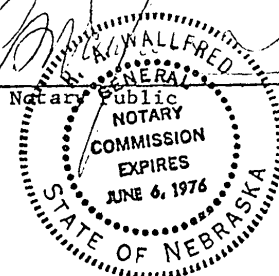
