COVENANT FOR STORM WATER DETENTION

The undersigned, being the owner of the following described property, to-wit:

Lots 1-3 and 5-9, High Point Replat 6, a subdivision as surveyed, platted and recorded in Douglas County, Nebraska

does hereby declare that the above described lots shall be subject to the following restriction in order to address the hydraulic overloading of the existing down stream storm sewer in the following manner, to-wit:

- 1. That Lots 1 9, High Point Replat 6 in their entirety, have been designated to contain within their boundaries a total of 27,300 cubic feet of storm water discharge in the aggregate.
- 2. The amount to be detained by each lot shall be determined by the lot owner's engineer and approved by the City engineer for the City of Elkhorn ("City") as part of the site plan approval process.
- 3. Site plans for each lot, shall show the storm water detention area and capacity as approved by City engineers.

This covenant shall run with the land and shall run in favor of the owners of each and every lot described above and the City of Elkhorn, their successors and assigns.
