BARNES' SUBDIVISION Comprises all that portion of the NE 1/4 of Section 20 T. 10 N. R. 7 E. of the 6th P.M. Lancaster County Neb., lying north of the right of way of the Missouri Pacific Railroad, said right of way line being 50 ft. north of the center of the track.

North street is 33 feet wide. Mable, Thompson, Law streets are each 60 ft wide. All lots have dimensions as marked in feet and decimals in red figures on the plat. Black figures indicate lot numbers.

Oak stakes are driven at all lot corners. Stones are planted at points marked thus O except on North line of Grant st.
