ORDINANCE NO. 16517

01 AN ORDINANCE creating Sewer District No. 1150, providing for the
02 payments of the costs of the improvements constructed therein, designating the
03 property to be benefited, providing for the acquisition of easements and
04 additional right-of-way, if necessary, and repealing all ordinances or parts
05 of ordinances in conflict herewith.

06 BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Lincoln, Nebraska:

07 Section 1. That Sewer District No. 1150 be and the same is hereby
08 created for the purpose of constructing an 8-inch diameter sanitary sewer or
09 sanitary sewers in Southwest 27th Street from approximately 300.0 feet south
10 of West 'O' Street to approximately 1150.0 feet south thereof, in said City.

11 Section 2. Said district shall include the following described real
12 estate benefited, to-wit: Lots 6, 7 and 16, Block 1, Western State Industrial
13 Tract 1st Addition; Lot 6, Block 1, and Lot 7, Block 3, Western State
14 Industrial Tract; the east 150.0 feet of the south 150.0 feet of Lot 78, the
15 east 150.0 feet of Lots 67 and 93, and the east 150.0 feet of that portion of
16 Lot 94 lying north of a line located 150.0 feet north of and parallel with the
17 north line of the Burlington Northern Railroad right-of-way, all Irregular
18 Tracts located in the Northeast Quarter of Section 29, Township 10 North,
19 Range 6 East of the 6th Principal Meridian; and all that portion of vacated
20 Southwest 27th Street lying north of a line located 150.0 feet north of and
21 parallel with the north line of the Burlington Northern Railroad right-of-way.

22 Section 3. The cost of the construction of the sewers to accommodate
23 said district shall be assessed against the property in said district
24 benefited in proportion to the benefits, not exceeding the cost of said

01 sewers. In the event that easements or additional right-of-way must be
02 acquired for the completion of the proposed construction within this district,
03 such property rights may be acquired by negotiation and purchase or by
04 condemnation, if necessary, as provided by law.

05 Section 4. That Ordinance No. 12754 and all ordinances or parts of
06 ordinances in conflict herewith, be and the same hereby are repealed.

07 Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and
08 after its passage and publication according to law, but construction shall
09 not be commenced until ordered by resolution by the City Council.

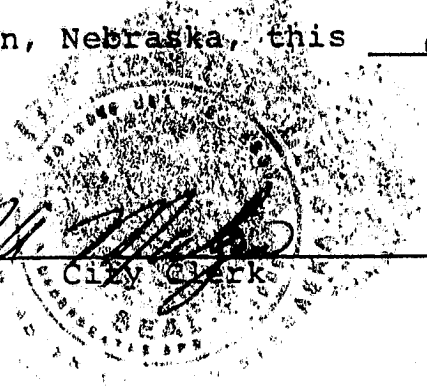
