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## **RESOLUTION 2002-44**

A RESOLUTION TO DECLARE NECESSITY AND ESTABLISH AN URBAN RENEWAL AREA, PURSUANT TO SECTION 403.4 OF THE CODE OF IOWA AND APRROVE URABN RENEWAL PLAN AMENDMENT FOR THE 2002 ADDITION TO THE DOWNTOWN URBAN RENEWAL AREA.

WHEREAS, as a preliminary step to exercising the authority conferred upon Iowa cities by Chapter 403 of the Code of Iowa (the "Urban Renewal Law"), a municipality must adopt a resolution finding that one or more slums, blighted or economic development areas exist in the municipality and that the rehabilitation, conservation, redevelopment, development or a combination thereof, of such area or areas is necessary in the interest of the public health, safety or welfare of the residents of the municipality; and

WHEREAS, this Council created the Downtown Urban Renewal Area (the "Urban Renewal Area"); and

WHEREAS, studies have been conducted which show the desirability of expanding the Urban Renewal Area to add and include all the property within the legal description set out on Exhibit A hereto; and

WHEREAS, studies found that sufficient need exists to warrant finding the area shown in Exhibit A an economic development area; and

WHEREAS, notice of a public hearing by the City Council of the City of Eagle Grove, Iowa, on the question of establishing the area shown on Exhibit A hereto as an urban renewal area and on a proposed urban renewal plan amendment for the 2002 Addition to the Downtown Urban Renewal Area was heretofore given in strict compliance with the provisions of Chapter 403 of the Code of Iowa, and the Council has conducted said hearing; and

WHEREAS, the proposed urban renewal plan amendment was submitted to and approved by the Planning and Zoning Commission of the City of Eagle Grove;

WHEREAS, copies of the urban renewal plan amendment, notice of public hearing and notice of a consultation meeting with respect to the urban renewal plan amendment were mailed to Wright County, Eagle Grove Community School District and the Iowa Central Community College; the consultation meeting was held on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of August, 2002; and responses to any comments or recommendations received following the consultation meeting were made as required by law;

NOW, THEREFORE, It Is Resolved by the City Council of the City of Eagle Grove, Iowa, as follows:

Section 1. An economic development area as defined in Chapter 403 of the Code of Iowa, is found to exist in the City of Eagle Grove within the boundaries set out on Exhibit A hereto.

- Section 2. The area identified in Section 1 hereof is hereby declared to be an urban renewal area, in conformance with the requirements of Chapter 403 of the Code of Iowa, and is hereby designated the 2002 Addition to the Downtown Urban Renewal Area.
- Section 3. The rehabilitation, conservation, redevelopment, development or a combination thereof, of this area is necessary in the interest of the public health, safety or welfare of the residents of the City of Eagle Grove, Iowa.
- Section 4. The amendment to the urban renewal plan for the Downtown Urban Renewal Area incorporating this area, attached hereto and made a part hereof, is hereby in all respects approved.
- Section 5. All resolutions or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed, to the extent of such conflict.
