


NOTICE OF POSSIBLE UNPAID WEED ASSESSMENT

TO THE LANCASTER COUNTY REGISTER OF DEEDS:

On June 9 & 10, 1987, the Lancaster County Noxious Weed Control Authority entered the tract of land described as:

NE 1/4 Sec. 28-T10-R6 Lot 95 I.T.

for the purpose of eradicating noxious weeds pursuant to Neb.Rev.Stat. §2-955. This tract of land is owned by Stuart A. Marx. The cost of such weed control measures was in the amount of \$ 1,418.75. Such cost was incurred at the expense of the aforementioned landowner(s). If said landowner(s) fail to pay such expense within two (2) months after the date control measures were taken, such expense shall become a lien on the aforementioned property taken as a special assessment levied on the date of control.


