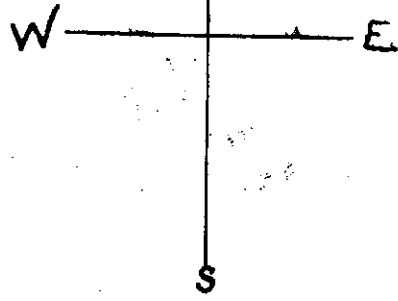
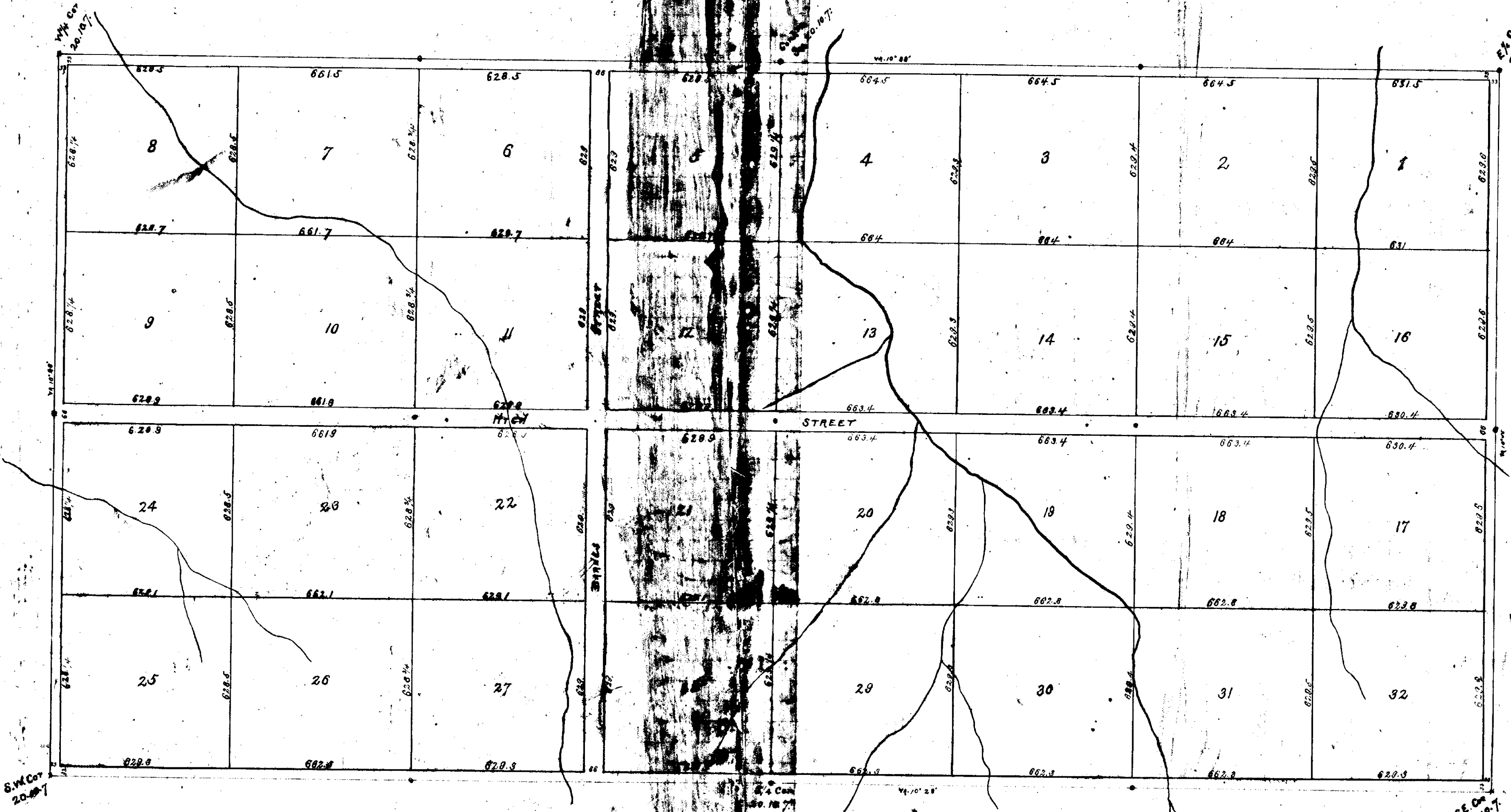


J.G. MILLER'S SUBDIVISION
