EASEMENT

The undersigned, hereinafter called "Grantor", hereby grants and conveys to OMAHA PUBLIC FOWER DISTRICT, hereinafter called "District", its successors and assigns a perpetual easement to construct, operate and maintain a 3 phase 66 kilo-volt electric transmission line, together with necessary poles, wires, guys and other fixtures and appliances, over, upon, along and above the property herein described, upon the terms and conditions set forth.

CONSIDERATIONS: One Hundred Twenty-five and No/100 - Dollars (\$ 125.00) PROPERTY COVERED AND RIGHT OF-WAY: Situated in Douglas County, Nebraŝka. That part of the East one-half ($E^{\frac{1}{2}}$) of the Southwest Quarter ($SW^{\frac{1}{4}}$) of Section One (1), Township Fourteen (14) North, Range Twelve_(12) East, lying Westerly of the Missouri-Pacific Railway Right of Way, also known as Tax Lot Seven (7).

Beginning at a point Two (2) feet more or less East of the West line of the East one-half ($E^{\frac{1}{2}}$) of the Southwest Quarter ($SW^{\frac{1}{4}}$) of Section One (1), said point being on the Southeasterly line of above described property and on the Northwesterly Right of Way line of the Missouri-Pacific Railway, thence Northerly to a point Two (2) feet more or less East of the Northwest corner of said East one-half ($E^{\frac{1}{2}}$) of the Southwest Quarter ($SW^{\frac{1}{4}}$) and on the North line of above described property, in Section One (1) above.

The wood poles to be set upon above described property shall not exceed five (5) in number, except that one additional wood-pole may be set upon said property, upon an additional payment of \$25.00 for such additional pole to Grantors, their successors or assigns.

CONDITIONS: The Grantor hereby grants to the District, its successors and assigns, the right, privilege and authority to enter upon and pass over said property and the property of the Grantor adjacent thereto for the purpose of some structing, repairing, operating and maintaining said lines and equipment upon the property above described.

The Grantor hereby grants to the District, its successors and assigns, the per manent right, privilege and authority to cut down trees under or within twenty-rive (25) feet of the District's lines, and to cut down or trim any trees or limbs of trees on either side thereof as would be a hazard to said lines in breaking off and falling over or against said lines. All refuse, or debris from such tree cutting and trimming shall be disposed of by furning

The District shall at all times exercise all due care and diligence to avoid any injury or damage to the crops, live stock and other personal property of the Grantor and the District agrees to indemnify and save harmless the Grantor from any and all such damage and less arising or occurring to such property solely by reason of the District's negligence in the construction, operation and maintenance of said electric line.

This exement is binding on the heirs, executors, administrators and assigns of Grantors.
