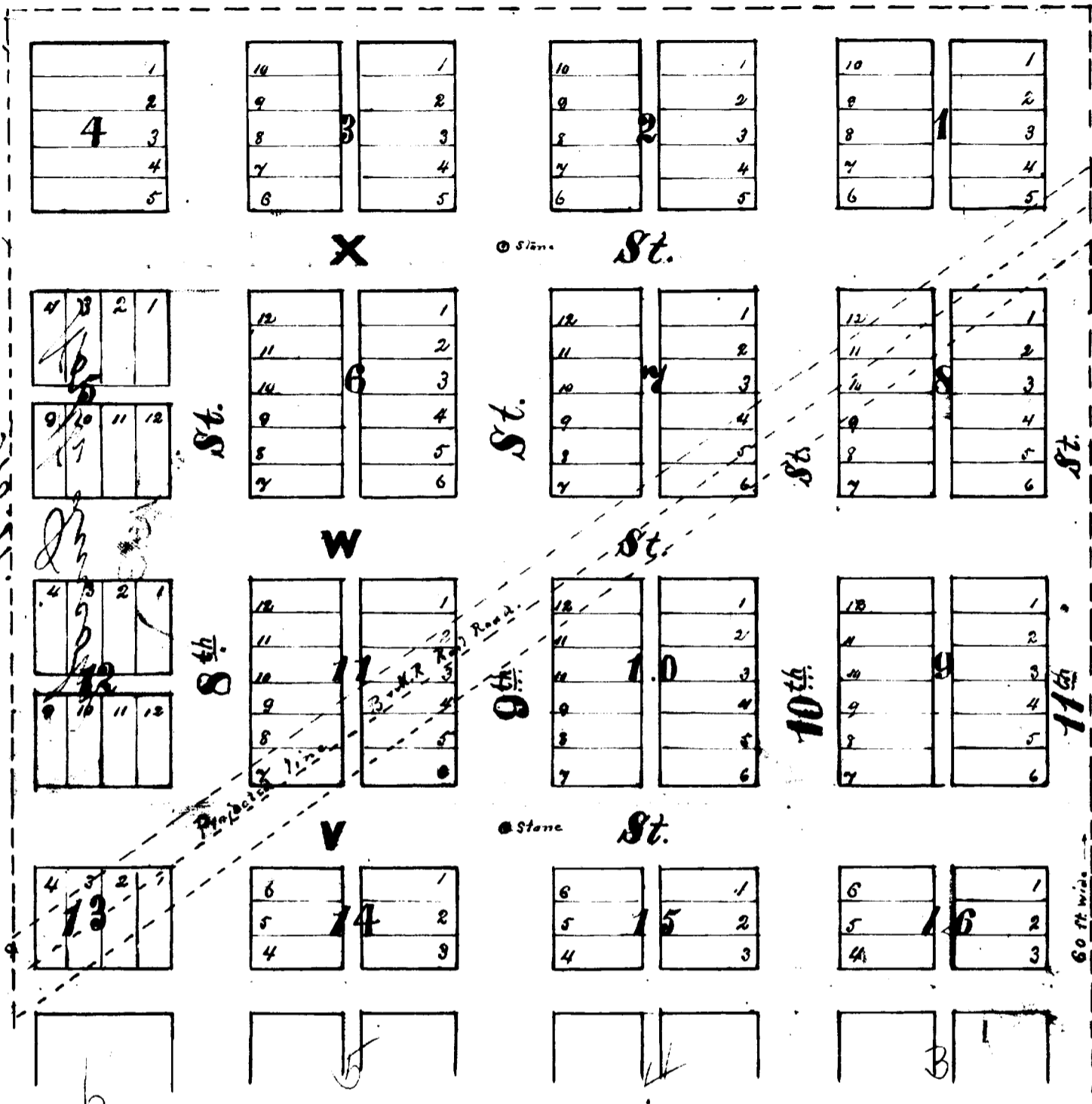

I, John W. Bradford, a competent surveyor do hereby certify that I have
 accurately surveyed the accompanying town plat known as North Lincoln, being
 said within the Gov. Stone Conduff Sec. in East 10th Section of T. 10 N. R. 6 E.
 established by County Survey of Lancaster County, in the Center of Section 33, T. 10 N. R. 6 E.
 that the lots, streets & alleys therein specified are well & accurately stated & marked. I and John W. Bradford

This is to certify that the accompanying Plat, the SW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 and part of the SE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Sec. 23 in Township 10, Range 6 lying in Lancaster County, State of Neb., is as known and designated as "North Lincoln" and as such Town, the streets and alleys as designated in the above Plat are set apart for Public Use and that the several descriptions of said grounds are as follows, to-wit: X, W, and V Streets, running East and West, are respectively 100 feet wide; 8th and 10th Streets, running North and South, are 100 feet wide; and 9th Street, running North and South, is 60 feet wide; and 11th Street running North and South is 60 feet wide. Streets on Northern and Western boundaries 30 feet wide, narrow ones. Stakes in Center of 8th and 9th and 10th and 11th Streets marked @.

Lots in Block 1, 2, 3, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 14, 15 and 16, are 60 feet wide by 142 feet long.

Lots in Block 4, are 50 feet wide by 100 feet long.

Lots in Block 13, are 50 feet wide by 100 feet long.

All Alleys are sixteen (16) feet wide.

And I further certify that the platting, surveying and setting apart of the said Tract of Land as a Town under the name of "North Lincoln" is my voluntary act and deed.
