


WEST BENSON

Omaha, Nebraska, August 2nd, 1915.

We hereby certify that we have surveyed and staked the lots, blocks, streets, alleys, reserves, park and lane of Blocks 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7, West Benson, Douglas County, Nebraska, and that the same is located as follows: Beginning at the $\frac{1}{4}$ corner common to Sections 10 and 11, Proj. 15 North, Range 12 East of the 6th P.M. Douglas County, Nebraska; thence West along the East and West center line of Section 10, 1060 feet to its intersection with the Easterly Right-of-Way line of the C. & N.W. Ry.; thence South only along the Easterly Right-of-Way line of the C. & N.W. Ry. 770.5 feet; thence North $70^{\circ}54'$ 600.150 feet to a point 685.2 feet West and 685 feet South of the $\frac{1}{4}$ corner common to Sections 10 and 11; thence East 1818.2 feet to a point on the Westerly line of 78th St. 184.7 feet West and 685 feet South of the N.E. corner of the N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 11; thence North Easterly along the Westerly line of 78th St. 367 feet to a point 276.2 feet West and 330 feet South of N.E. corner of the N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 11; thence Northerly by a curve to a point on the East and West center line of Section 11, 240 feet more or less West of the N.E. corner of the N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 11; thence West along the East and West center line of Section 11, 1077.3 feet to place of beginning.


