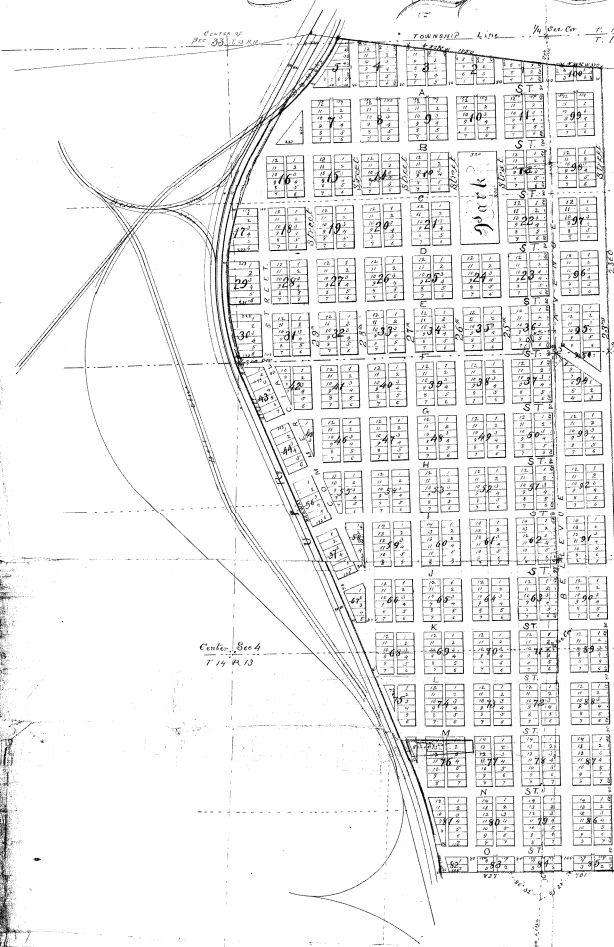

I certify that I have surveyed and staked off and marked the York Streets, Alley and Public grounds of South Omaha at Omaha, on the accompanying map, the same being advanced upon the following described lands, viz:

Beginning on the Township line between Township No. 19 and 15 North, at a point 450 ft East of the S. E. corner of Sec 33 of T. 15. R. 13. E. of the C. P. M. line North parallel to the line connecting the N. E. and S. E. corners of said Sec 33 a distance 2360 feet to the North boundary of what was known as the Lee Farm, then S 88° 10' 37 1/2" along the East boundary, less than 1800 ft to the boundary of the B. & O. R. R. to a point, then S 50° 1' 1/2" at right from center of location and then S 88° 10' 37 1/2" along said line of 1800 ft to the N. P. R. R. way, then S 88° 10' 37 1/2" along the East boundary of the B. & O. R. R. to a point, then East parallel to the first mentioned Township line 827 feet to a point in the line between Sec 33 and 34 of Town and Range as last above mentioned 127 feet west of the 1/4 sec. corner of said Sec 33 and 34. Said point being 119 feet east of the S. W. corner of said Sec 34, then North East course 701 ft to E line of Sec 33, then North parallel to the line between Sec 33 and 34 a distance 127 feet to place of beginning being 140 acres in Sec 33, 25 acres in line 34 of T. 15. 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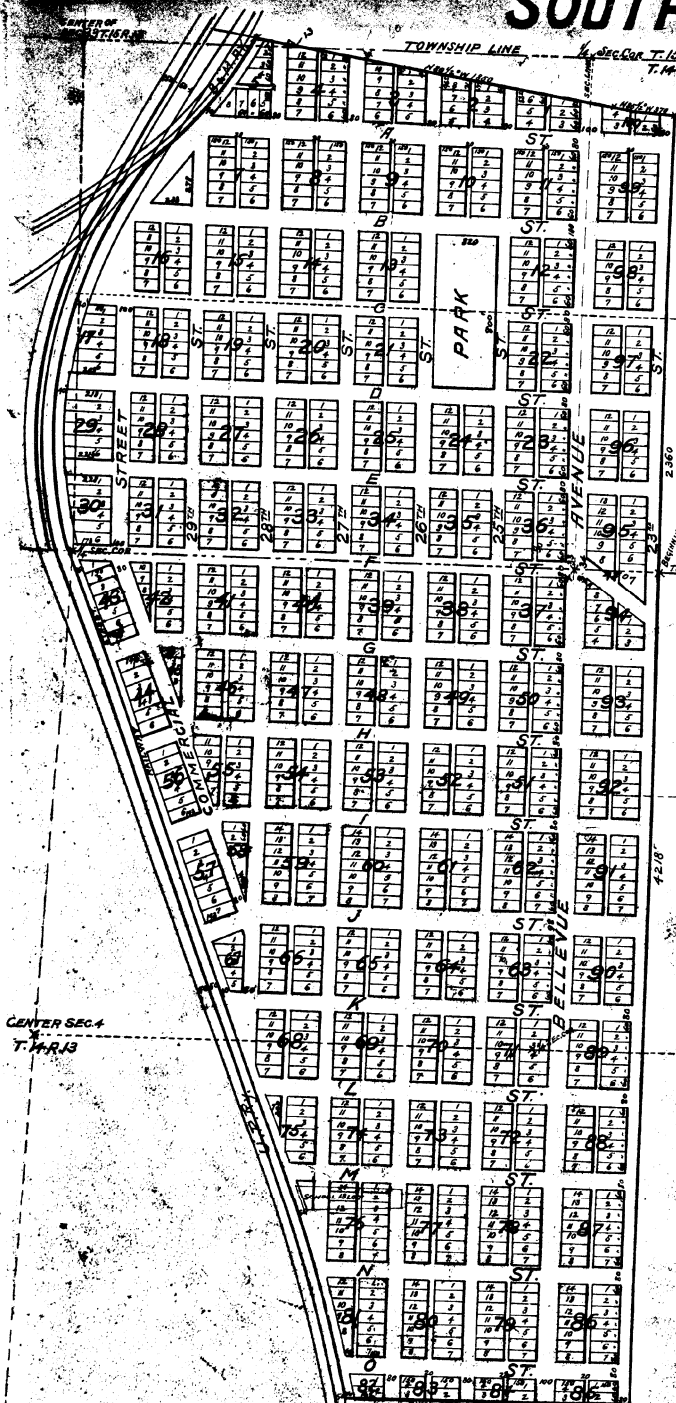
