ORDINANCE NUMBER 629.

An Ordinance vacating the fourteen foot alley running north and south in Block Eighteen of Carthage Addition, also the fourteen foot alley running east and west in Block one hundred and eleven of Dundee Place and providing for the attaching of said vacated allies to the abutting property.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF DUNDEE:

Section 1. That the fourteen foot alley heretofore existing and running north and south in Block Eighteen of Carthage Addition as surveyed, platted and recorded be and the same is hereby vacated, and the east seven feet of said alley be, and the same is hereby attached and shall become a part of each of Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, and 7 in Block 18 of said Carthage Addition, as surveyed, platted and recorded, and the west seven feet of said alley be, and the same is hereby attached and shall become a part of each of Lots 10, 11, 12, 13 and 14 of Block Eighteen of said Carthage Addition as surveyed, platted and recorded and Lot 1, of Furtz Sub-division of Lots 8 and 9 of Carthage Addition, as surveyed, platted and recorded.

Section 2. That the fourteen foot alley running east and west in Block 111 of Dundee Place as surveyed, platted and recorded be and the same is hereby vacated and the north seven feet of said alley shall be and the same is hereby attached and shall become a part of each of Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, and 12, in Block 111 of Dundee Place as surveyed, platted and recorded, and the south seven feet of said alley be and the same is hereby attached and shall become a part of Lots 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, and 24 in Block 111 of Dundee Place as surveyed, platted and recorded.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication as required by law.
