

ORDINANCE NO. 10897

An Ordinance declaring alley between 61st Street and Military Avenue from Wirt Street to Spencer Street widened and open to the public travel in the City of Omaha.

WHEREAS, Certain properties were accepted by the City Council in Resolution No. 7158 adopted on September 29th, 1925 for alley opening, described as follow:

THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OMAHA:

Section 1. That properties described below:

East seven feet of West 14 feet of Lots 4 and 21, Block 11, Benson, in the City of Omaha, be, and are hereby, declared open to the public travel as alley between 61st Street and Military Avenue from Wirt Street to Spencer Street to be improved as may be hereafter ordered and required.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force after fifteen days from and after its passage.
