

ORDINANCE NO. 12545

An Ordinance declaring the necessity of appropriating for drainage purposes certain private property and lands to be used by the City of Omaha in the opening of alleys between 61st and 63rd Streets from Wirt Street to East and West alley between Bedford Avenue and Emmet Street; and providing for the appointment of three disinterested freeholders of said City to assess the damages to the owners, respectively, of the property taken by such appropriation.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OMAHA:

Section 1. That it is proper and necessary, and it is hereby declared proper and necessary, to appropriate certain private property and lands for the use of the City of Omaha for the purpose of opening for drainage purposes, alleys between 61st and 63rd Streets from Wirt Street to East and West alley between Bedford Avenue and Emmet Street; the property and lands necessary for such purpose being situated in said City of Omaha, described as follows:

West seven feet of Lots 4 and 21; East seven feet of Lots 5 and 20; portion of Lot 4 lying South and West of a line connecting a point on the South line of Lot 4, 15 feet East of the South West Corner of same and a point seven feet East of the West line and eight feet North of the South line of Lot 4; also that portion of Lot 21 lying North and West of a line connecting a point on the North line of Lot 21, 15 feet East of the North West Corner of same and a point seven feet East of the West line and eight feet South of the North line of Lot 21; that part of Lot 5 lying South and East of a line connecting a point on the South line of Lot 5, 15 feet West of the South East Corner of said lot, and a point seven feet West of East line and eight feet North of South line of Lot 5; that part of Lot 20 lying North and East of a line connecting a point on the North line of said Lot 20, 15 feet West of the North East Corner of same and a point seven feet West of the East line and eight feet South of the North line of Lot 20; in Block 11:

West seven feet of Lots 5 and 21; East seven feet of Lots 6 and 20; in Block 12; also the triangular portions adjoining in Block 12, as follows:

That part of Lot 5 lying South and West of a line connecting a point 15 feet East of the South West Corner of same and a point seven feet East of the West line and eight feet North of the South line of said Lot 5.

That part of Lot 6 lying South and East of a line connecting point 15 feet West of the South East Corner of same and a point seven feet West of the East line, eight feet North of the South line of Lot 6.

That part of Lot 20 lying North and East of a line connecting point on the North line of Lot 20, 15 feet West of the North East Corner of same and a point seven feet West of the East line and eight feet South of the North line of Lot 20.

That part of Lot 21 lying North and West of a line connecting point on the North line of said Lot 21, 15 feet East of the North West Corner of same and a point seven feet East of the West line and eight feet South of the North line of Lot 21.

East 14 feet of West 32 feet of Lot 18, and the triangular portions adjoining in Block 13, as follows:

Beginning at point on the North line of Lot 18, 18 feet West of the North East Corner of said Lot 18; thence East along North line of Lot 18 for a distance of eight feet; thence in a Southwesterly direction along a straight line to a point eight feet South of the North line and 32 feet East of the West line of Lot 18; thence North along a line 32 feet East of and parallel to the West line of Lot 18, for a distance of eight feet, to the place of beginning.

Also beginning at a point on the North line of Lot 18, 18 feet East of North West Corner of same; thence South along a line 18 feet East of and parallel to the West line of Lot 18 for a distance of eight feet; thence along a straight line in a Northwesterly direction to a point on the North line of Lot 18, 10 feet East of the North West Corner of said Lot 18; thence East along the North line of Lot 18 for a distance of eight feet to the place of beginning, Block 13.

All of the above described property being in Original City of Benson.

Section 2. That the Mayor, with the approval of the City Council, appoint three disinterested freeholders of the City of Omaha to assess the damages to the owners, respectively, of said property and lands taken by such appropriation.

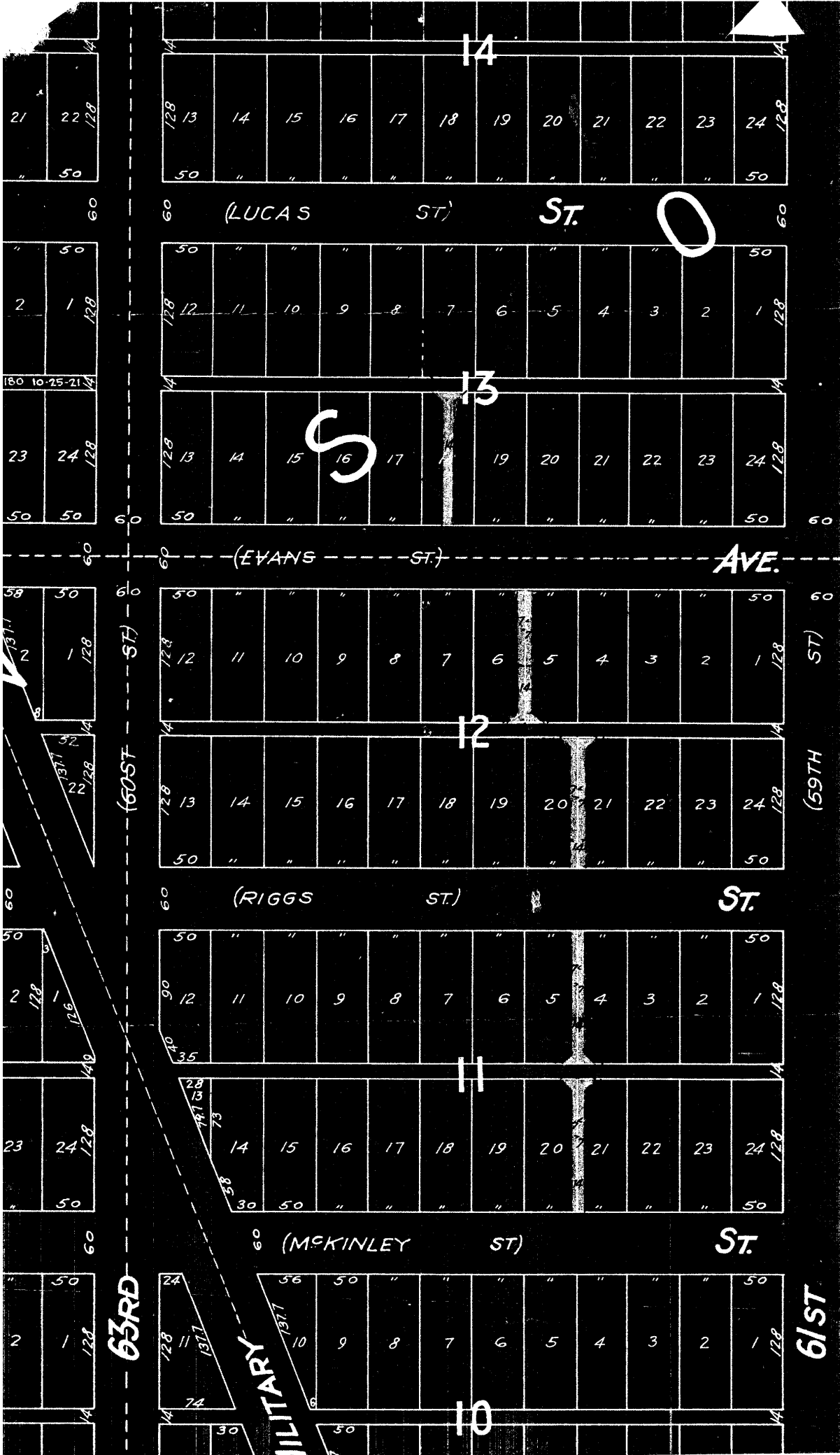
Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force after fifteen days from and after its passage.

An ordinance declaring the necessity of appropriating for drainage purposes certain private property and lands to be used by the City of Omaha in the opening of streets between 61st and 63d streets from Wirt street to 22nd and 24th streets, and providing for the appointment of three disinterested freeholders of said City to assess the damages to the owners, respectively, of the property taken by such appropriation.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OMAHA: Section 1. That it is proper and necessary, and it is hereby declared proper and necessary, to appropriate certain private property and lands for the use of the City of Omaha for the purpose of opening for drainage purposes, alleys between 61st and 63d streets from Wirt street to east and west alley between Bedford avenue and Emmet street; and providing for the appointment of three disinterested freeholders of said City to assess the damages to the owners, respectively, of the property taken by such appropriation.

Section 2. That the Mayor, with the approval of the City Council, appoint three disinterested freeholders of the City of Omaha to assess the damages to the owners, respectively, of said property and lands taken by such appropriation.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force after fifteen days from and after its passage.
