KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That THE FIRST TRUST COMPANY OF LINCOLN, NEBRASKA, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of individually and as Nebraska, Trustee under Loan No. 26589, in consideration of the sum of ONE AND NO/100 DOLLARS the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does hereby GRANT, BARGAIN and SELL to Nebraska Central Building and Loan Association, a Corporation, successors i.s.heirs, and assigns, the following described property situate in the County of Lancaster, State of Nebraska, to-wit:

\*North Nine and Five-tenths (9.5) feet only of West Five and One-tenths (5.1) feet of South Fourteen (14) feet of Lot Four (4), and North Nine and Five-tenths (9.5) feet only of East Thirty and Nine-tenths (30.9) feet of South Fifty-seven and Three-tenths (57.3) feet of Lot Two (2), all in Rathbone's Prescott Addition to Lincoln, in Lancaster County, Nebraska.

This deed is subject to the following specific conditions and limitations: Same conveys only that portion of the garage walls and roof and floor and partitions located upon the specific tract above described, and does not convey any portion of the garage walls or roof or floor or foundation or footings or partitions, or any easement therein or in the ground covered thereby, that are located to the south of and beyond the boundary lines of the specific tract above described.
