The undersigned, duly appointed by the Court by order dated December 26, , 1963, appraisers of the land sought to be condemned in this proceeding, and hereinafter described, have duly qualified by taking the oath prescribed by law, and notice having been given as prescribed by law to all owners and parties interested in said land, do hereby report that pursuant to the notice given and proceedings had, we, on this 15 ____ day of __January ___, 196<u>4</u>, being the day specified in said notice, each separately and as a body did carefully inspect and view the lands named in said petition and hereinafter described, and heard all parties interested therein in reference to the amount of damages, and we do hereby assess the damages which the owners of said land, all persons interested therein have sustained by reason of the taking and appropriating of said lands and easements for street ourposes and municipal purposes generally by the City of Lincoln, described as follows:

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To obtain a permanent sanitary sever easement described as follows:

A strip of land 15 feet in width across Lot 34 of Irregular Tracts in the Southwest Quarter of Section 1, Township 9 North, Range 6 East of the 6th Principal Meridian in Lancaster County, Nebraska, and whose center line is more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the north line of Pioneers
Boulevard 185 feet east of the conterline of 14th Street;
running thence northeasterly along the arc of a circular
curve bearing to the right, whose tangent deflects 8° degrees
04 minutes right from the said north line of Pioneers
Boulevard, whose radius is 259.55 feet, and whose central
angle is 32 degrees 14 minutes, a distance of 146.02 feet
to a point of tangency with a straight line; thence
northeasterly along a straight line, a distance of 125.14
feet to a point of intersection with the R.O.W. line of
the C.B. & Q. R.R.; said point being 291.79 feet cast of
the centerline of 14th Street.

Beginning at a point on the north line of Pioneers Boulevard 185 feet east of the centerline of 14th Street; running thence northeasterly along the arc of a circular curve bearing to the right, whose tangent deflects 89 degrees 04 minutes right from the said north line of Pioneers Boulevard, whose radius is 259,55 feet, and whose central angle is 32 degrees 14 minutes, a distance of 146.02 feet to a point of tangency with a straight line; thence northeasterly along a straight line, a distance of 125.14 feet to a point of intersection with the south R.O.W. line of the C.B. & Q.
