That the portion of 67th Street lying between the north line of Seward Avenue and a point 150.0 feet north thereof, in the Northeast Quarter of Section 9, Township 10 North, Range 7 East of the 6th P.M., Lincoln, Lancaster County, Nebraska, be and the same is hereby vacated, subject to the title of said street portion being vacated remaining in the City of Lincoln, Nebraska.


