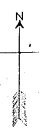

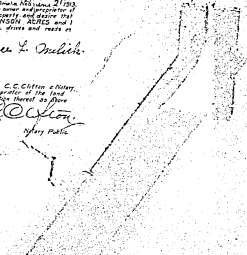

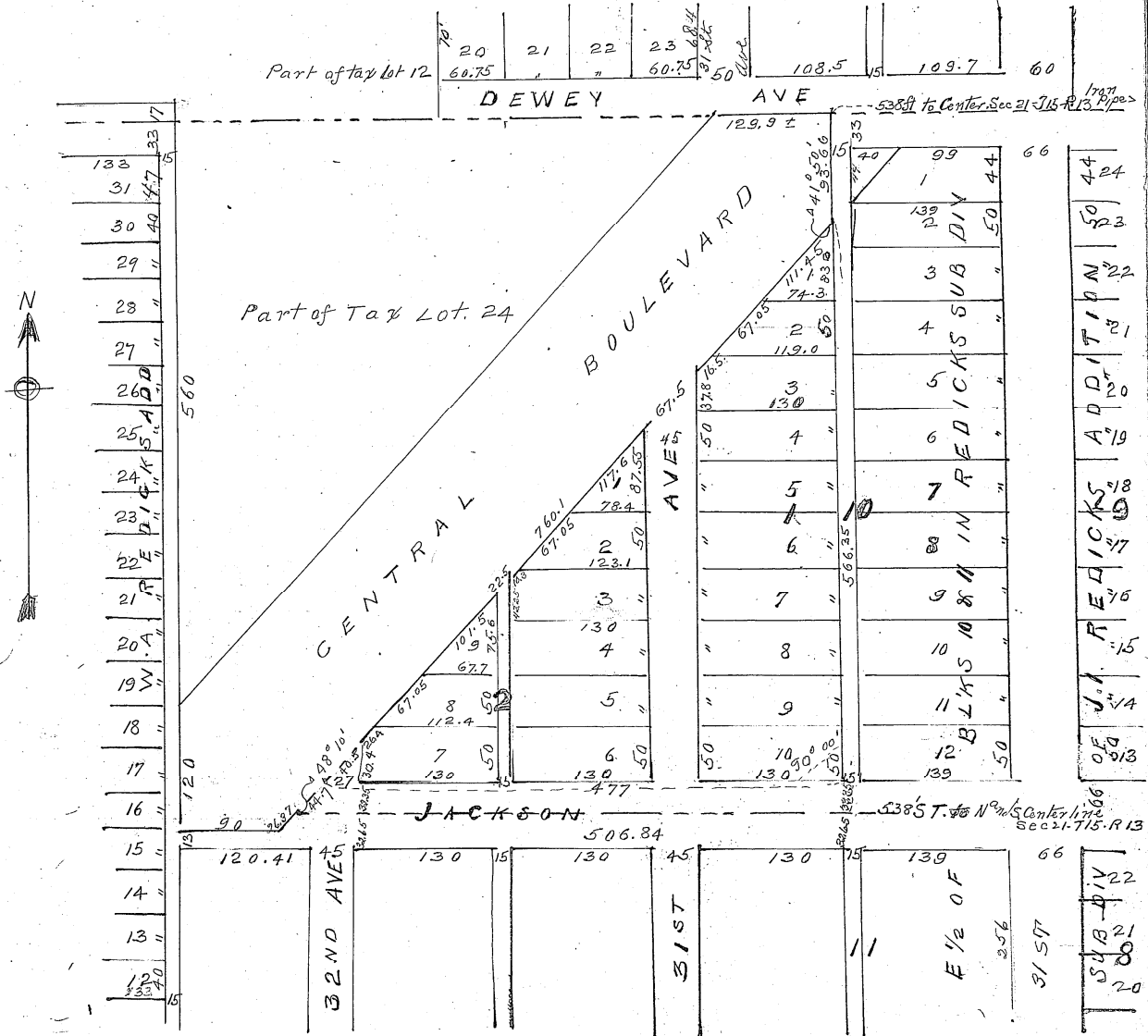


E. S. REDICKS ADD

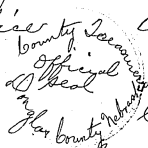
