## ORDINANCE NO. 16675

AN ORDINANCE to amend part of Ordinance No. 16636, revising the description of land to be vacated by said Ordinance No. 16636, and repealing any and all ordinances or amendments to ordinances insofar as they conflict herewith.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OMAHA:

Section 1. That the following description of property to be vacated in Ordinance No. 16636, which now reads as follows:

"That portion of Nicholas St. adj. Blk.  $183\frac{1}{2}$ , Original City of Omaha described as follows: Beginning 9 ft. East of SW corner of Lot 7, Block  $183\frac{1}{2}$ , thence west 18 feet, thence North 38 feet to S.L. of Lot 6 in said Block  $183\frac{1}{2}$ , thence East 18 ft. along S.L. of Lot 6 and 7 in said Block  $183\frac{1}{2}$ , Original City of Omaha to pt. of beginning,"

be amended to read as follows:

"That portion of Nicholas Street adj. Block  $183\frac{1}{2}$ , Original City of Omaha described as follows: Beginning 9 feet East of SW corner of Lot 7, Block  $183\frac{1}{2}$ , thence South 38 feet, thence west 18 feet, thence North 38 feet to S.L. of Lot 6 in said Block  $183\frac{1}{2}$ , thence East 18 feet along the S.L. of Lots 6 and 7 in said Block  $183\frac{1}{2}$ , Original City of Omaha to pt. of beginning,"

Section 2. That the descriptions as contained in Ordinance No. 16636, passed May 2, 1950, be, and the same hereby are, repealed, such repeal to be effective as of the effective date of this Ordinance.

Section 3. That the remaining part of Ordinance No. 16636, with the exception of the portion thereof heretofore set out, shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. That all ordinances or amendments thereto only insofar as they conflict herewith be, and the same hereby are, repealed.

Section 5. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after fifteen days after its passage.
