Introduce: 2-23-98

AN ORDINANCE creating Paving District No. 2614, defining the limits thereof, establishing the width of the roadway to be paved and the width of the grading to be done, providing for the curbing, guttering, and relaying of sidewalks, providing for the payment of the cost thereof, designating the property to be benefited, providing for the acquisition of easements and additional right-of-way, if necessary, and repealing all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Lincoln, Nebraska:

Section 1. That Paving District No. 26/4, of the City of Lincoln, Nebraska, be and the same is hereby created; that said paving district shall include all that portion of West 'S' Street from a point located 33.55 feet east of the centerline of North Coddington Avenue to a point located 33.00 feet west of the centerline of Northwest 20th Street, in said City.

Section 2. Said district shall include the following described real estate benefited, to-wit: Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7, S.C. Smith II Subdivision; Lots 1 and 14, the north 14.425 feet of Lot 2, and the north 15.055 feet of Lot 13, Western Manor Subdivision; and all that portion of the south 300.00 feet of Lot 111 lying east of a line located 33.55 feet east of the centerline of North Coddington Avenue extended north, said Lot 111 is an Irregular Tract located in the Southwest Quarter of Section 21, Township 10 North, Range 6 East of the 6th Principal Meridian in the City of Lincoln, Lancaster County, Nebraska.

Section 3. The roadway to be paved in said district shall be 27 feet in width; grading to be from lot line to lot line, and the cost of grading, curbing, guttering, and paving the same, including the cost of grading, curbing, guttering, and paving the returns, and the cost of grading

- the sidewalk space and relaying of sidewalks and all expenses incidental to all of said 1
- improvements shall be assessed against the property benefited in said district in proportion to the 2
- provided, however, that such special assessbenefits, not exceeding the cost thereof; In the event that easements or additional right-of-way 3
- must be acquired for the completion of this district, such property rights may be acquired by 4
- negotiation and purchase or by condemnation, if necessary, as provided by law. 5
  - Section 4. That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same hereby are repealed.
    - Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication according to law, but construction shall not be commenced until ordered by resolution by the City Council.
