EASEMENT

By this instrument the undersigned Marshall Nurseries Company, a corporation, conveys to Sperling Brothers, a parthership, an easement upon and over that strip of property located along the east side of the Southwest One-quarter Section 17, Township 17 N, Range 10, Washington County, Nebraska, being 32 feet in width.
