Haney, single, of the county of Douglas and state of Nebraska first parties for and in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred and no/100 Dollars to us in hand paid by Elkhorn River Drainage District second party, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said second party its successors or assigns, all that certain tract, piece or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the county of Dodge and state of Nebraska and described as follows, to wit: A strip or piece of land ninety feet wide being 45 feet wide on each side of the center line of the cut off ditch, drainage ditch or levee each or all as the case may be as the same is now surveyed and located by second party and extending across from the west side to the east and south side of the south west quarter of the north east quarter of section twenty two in township seventeen range nine together with any and all desired access thereto by said drainage district, its agents, contractors, representatives and employees across other portions of said land of first parties.
