SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

I hereby certify that I have made a ground survey of the subdivision described herein and that temporary monuments have been placed on the boundary of the within plat and that a bond has been furnished to the City of Omaha to insure placing of permanent monuments and stakes at all corners of all lots, streets, angle points, and ends of all curves in Miracle Hills Park (Lots 1 thru 23, inclusive), being a platting of part of the West 1/2 of Section 17 and part of the SW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of said Section 17, Township 15 North, Range 12 East of the 6th P.M., Douglas County, Nebraska, more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the Southeast corner of the SW 1/4 of said Section 17; thence N00°12'14"E (assumed bearing), along the East line of said SW 1/4 of Section 17, a distance of 240.00 feet to a point on the North right-of-way line of West Dodge Road, said point also being the Point of Beginning; thence S89°27'59"W, along said North right-of-way line of West Dodge Road, a distance of 49.50 feet; thence N00°12'14"E, a distance of 959.80 feet; thence Northwest on a curve to the left with a radius of 250.00 feet, a distance of 129.72 feet, said curve having a long chord which bears N14°39'35"W, a distance of 128.27 feet to a point on the South line of the NW 1/2 of said SW 1/4 of Section 17; thence S89°29'39"W, along said South line of the NW 1/2 of the SW 1/4 of Section 17, a distance of 1510.70 feet to a point on the East right-of-way line of 120th Street; thence S00°00'17"W, along said East right-of-way line of 120th Street, a distance of 1772.72 feet; thence N89°11'19"E, a distance of 752.31 feet; thence N73°10'38"E, a distance of 101.14 feet; thence N38°13'44"E, a distance of 136.68 feet; thence N64°35'55"E, a distance of 182.99 feet; thence N64°20'10"E, a distance of 402.82 feet; thence S15°05'27"E, a distance of 1533.37 feet; thence Southeast on a curve to the right with a radius of 350.00 feet, a distance of 178.22 feet to a point on the South line of said NW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 17; thence S89°29'39"W, along said South line of the NW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 17, a distance of 27.29 feet to the Northeast corner of the SE 1/4 of said NW 1/4 of Section 17; thence S00°12'14"W, along said East line of the SW 1/4 of Section 17, a distance of 1088.17 feet to the Point of Beginning.

DEDICATION

Know all men by these presents that we, Tyler B. Gaines, Trustee and Silvercrest Developers, Inc., owners; and First National Bank of Omaha, mortgagee of the property described in the certification of survey and embraced within this plat have caused said land to be subdivided into lots and streets to be numbered and named as shown, said subdivision to be hereinafter known as Miracle Hills Park (Lots 1 thru 23 inclusive) and we do hereby ratify and approve of the disposition of our property as shown on this plat, and we do hereby grant the easements as shown on this plat. We do further grant a perpetual easement to the Omaha Public Power District, and N.W. Bell Telephone Company, and any company which has been granted a franchise to provide a Cable Television System in the area to be subdivided, their successors and assigns, to erect, operate, maintain, repair and remove poles, wires, cables, conduits and other related facilities, and to extend thereon wires or cables, for the carrying and transmission of electric current for light, heat and power and for transmission of signals and sounds of all kinds including signals provided by a cable television system and the reception on, over, through, under and across a five foot (5') wide strip of land abutting all front and side boundary lines of all interior lots; and a sixteen foot (16') wide strip of land abutting the rear boundary lines of all exterior lots. The rear exterior lots herein defined as those lots forming the outer perimeter of the above described addition. Said sixteen foot (16') wide easement will be reduced to an eight foot (8') wide strip when the adjacent land is surveyed, platted and recorded. No permanent buildings or retaining walls shall be placed in the said Easement way, but the same may be used for gardens, shrubs, landscaping and other purposes that do not then or later interfere with the aforesaid uses or right herein granted.

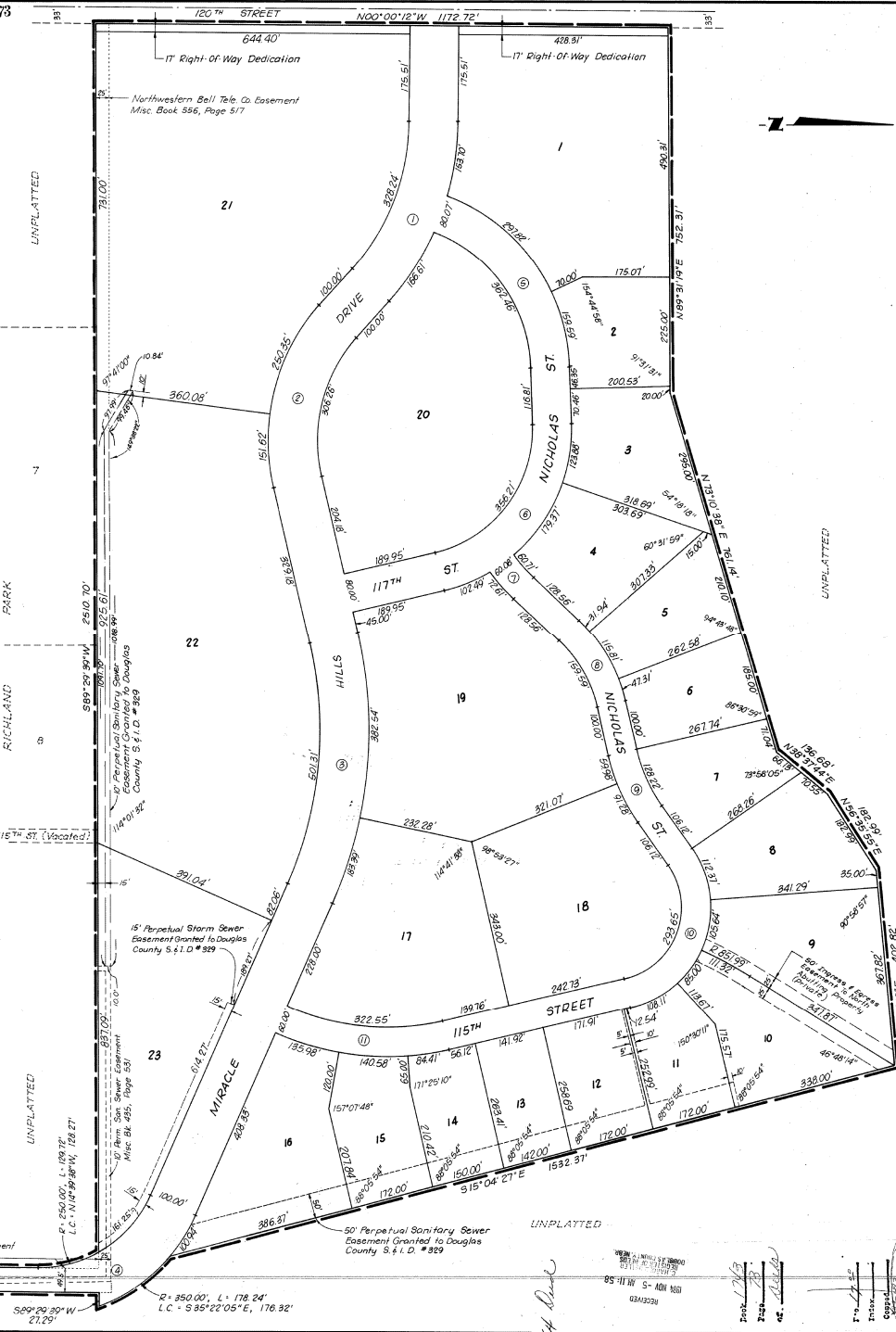
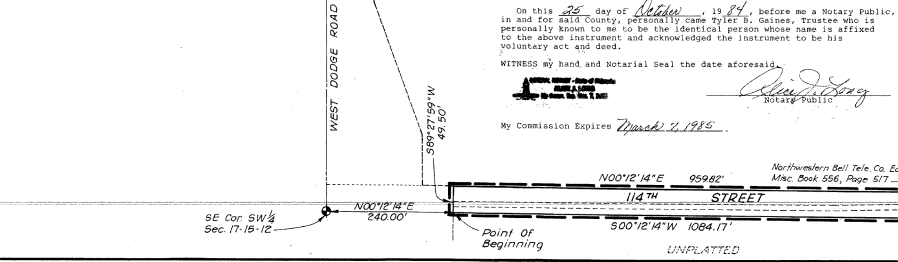
