

An ordinance approving the plat of Morton Acres Second Addition to the City of Beatrice, Nebraska, as executed and acknowledged by the owners thereof and as certified by the surveyor of said addition, declaring said addition to be a part of the City of Beatrice, Gage County, Nebraska, designated ^{as the} use districts in which said subdivision shall be included, and to repeal all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEATRICE, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. That the plat of Morton Acres Second Addition to the City of Beatrice, Nebraska, as executed and acknowledged by the owners thereof, Donald Morton, President, and Maurine Morton, Secretary-Treasurer, sole owners of Morton Realty Co., a corporation, and Mabel Claire Morton, a widow, Harold D. Robertson and wife, Jacqueline E. Robertson, Harry P. Doyle and wife, Amelia M. Doyle, on the 13th day of April, 1964, be and the same hereby is approved.

Section 2. That the land included within said Morton Acres Second Addition to the City of Beatrice, Nebraska, comprised of Blocks 1 through 10 Morton Acres Second Addition to the City of Beatrice, Gage County, Nebraska, be and the same hereby is declared to be a part of the city of Beatrice, Nebraska, and the corporate limits of said City are hereby extended so as to take in and include said described property.

Section 3. That Blocks 8, 9 and 10 are designated as B1 Local Business District as defined in Article 601 and 602 of the 1959 Revised Zoning Ordinances of the City of Beatrice, Nebraska.

Section 4. That all the remaining blocks and parts of blocks included in the real estate described above be and hereby are included in the R1 one and two-family ^{dwelling} districts.

Section 5. That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

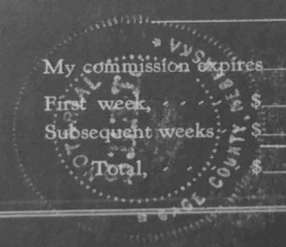

Ordinance 1462

ORDINANCE NUMBER 1462 An ordinance approving the plat of Morton Acres Second Addition to the City of Beatrice, Nebraska, as executed and acknowledged by the owners thereof and as certified by the surveyor of said addition, declaring said addition to be a part of the City of Beatrice, Gage County, Nebraska, designating the districts in which said subdivision shall be included, and to repeal all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEATRICE, NEBRASKA: Section 1. That the plat of Morton Acres Second Addition to the City of Beatrice, Nebraska, as executed and acknowledged by the owners thereof, Donald Morton, President, and Maurine Morton, Secretary - Treasurer, sole owners of Morton Realty Co., a corporation and Mabel Claire Morton, a widow, Harold D. Robertson and wife, Jacqueline E. Robertson, Harry P. Doyle and wife, Amelia M. Doyle, on the 13th day of April, 1964, be and the same hereby is approved.

Section 2. That the land included within said Morton Acres Second Addition to the City of Beatrice, Nebraska, comprised of Blocks 1 through 10 Morton Acres Second Addition to the City of Beatrice, Gage County, Nebraska, be and the same hereby is declared to be a part of the city of Beatrice, Nebraska, and the corporate limits of said City are hereby extended so as to take in and include said described property.

Section 3. That Blocks 8, 9 and 10 are designated as B1 Local Business District as defined in Article 801 and 802 of the 1959 Revised Zoning Ordinances of the City of Beatrice, Nebraska.

Section 4. That all the remaining blocks and parts of blocks included in the real estate described above be and hereby are included in the B1 one and two-family Dwellings districts.

Section 5. That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 6. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
