

I hereby certify that I have accurately surveyed and staked off the $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 3 T. 10 N. R. 7 E. of the 6th P.M. and a strip of land off the South end of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 3, described as follows: Beginning at the SW corner of the said NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and running North along the Section line 188 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to the South line of First Street in Norwood Park; thence East along said South line of First Street 132 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to the East line of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$; thence South 128 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to the SE corner of said NW $\frac{1}{4}$; thence West 132 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to the place of beginning; (said strip having been formerly platted as Blocks 30, 31, 32, and 33 in Norwood Park) into Lots, Blocks, Streets, and Alleys as shown by the annexed plat of the FIRST ADDITION to Norwood Park.

Pennsylvania Avenue and Jackson Street are each 33 feet wide. Richmond, Ridgeland and Maywood Avenues are each 30 feet wide and are continuations of the lines of the same streets in Norwood Park. Kedzie, Tremont, Loomis, Bishop, Laflin, Burlington and Lincoln streets are each 55 feet wide.

The alleys in Blocks 30, 31, 32 and 33 are 16 feet wide. All other alleys are 14 feet wide.

All lots have dimensions as indicated in feet and decimals on the plat. All lines except the East, South and West boundaries are parallel with or at right angles to Richmond Avenue.

Oak stakes are set at all lot corners on the block lines. Stones are set at points marked thus O
