KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That the United States of America, acting by and through the Federal Farm Mortgage Corporation, under and pursuant to the powers and authority contained in the provisions of the Surplus Property Act of 1944 (58 Stat. 765); Regulation No. 1 of the Surplus Property Board (10 F.R. 3764); Order of the Secretary of Agriculture, dated April 26, 1945 (10 F.R. 4647); and Order of the Governor of the Farm Credit Administration, dated April 28, 1945 (10 F.R. 4694), grantor, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable consideration, to it in hand paid, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does hereby release and quitclaim unto Polk County, State of Iowa, an easement and right to extend, construct and maintain for the use of the general public, roads and highways over and across the following described lands in Polk County, Iowa:

North 50 feet of the Northeast Quarter of Section 34; the North 50 feet of the Northwest Quarter of Section 35; the South 50 feet of the Southeast Quarter of Section 27; the South 50 feet of the South Half of Section 26, including in such description the South 17 feet of Lots 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 19, and 20 of North Hope, an official plat of the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter and the South Half of the Southeast Quarter of Section 26, except such portion of the South 50 feet of the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 26 as may have heretofore been conveyed to the State of Iowa by deed dated January 1, 1947, all in Township 60, North, Range 24, West of the 9th Principal Meridian.

Reserving, however, in the United States, its successors and assigns, an easement for the continued use, operation, maintenance and repair of the utility lines now located across the said premises, whether above or below the ground, consisting of railway, water, sewer, gas, light and power, and telephone lines.

The aforesaid premises were declared surplus, and were assigned to the Federal Farm Mortgage Corporation as disposal agency, pursuant to the provisions of the above Act, Regulation and Orders.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the United States of America has caused these presents to be executed in its name by the Federal Farm Mortgage Corporation and the seal of said corporation to be hereunto fixed this 11 day of January 1947.
