

ORDINANCE NO. 14242

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE AVENUE OR APPROACH TO CONNECT DODGE STREET AND SADDLE CREEK ROAD AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE PRESENT INTERSECTION OF SAID STREET AND ROAD, IN THE CITY OF OMAHA, OPEN TO THE PUBLIC FOR PUBLIC TRAVEL.

WHEREAS, It has been duly declared necessary by Ordinance No. 14208 to appropriate certain lands and real estate for the use of the City of Omaha for the purpose of making an avenue or approach to connect Dodge Street and Saddle Creek Road at the northeast corner of the present intersection thereof; and

WHEREAS, Three disinterested freeholders of the City who, after being duly sworn to perform the duties of their appointment with fidelity and impartiality, have assessed the damages to the owners of the property taken by such appropriation; and,

WHEREAS, Such assessment has been duly reported to the City Council for confirmation and has been duly approved and confirmed; and

WHEREAS, All other requirements of law relating to the appropriation of private property for the use of the City for the purpose aforesaid have been complied with; THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OMAHA:

Section 1. That the avenue or approach to connect Dodge Street and Saddle Creek Road at the northeast corner of the intersection of said street and road be, and the same is hereby, declared open to the public for public travel, to be improved as may hereafter be ordered or required.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force after fifteen days from and after its passage.
