RIGHT-OF-WAY EASEMENT

The easement shall be six feet in width, being three feet (3.0) on each side of, and parallel to, the entire length of existing facilities as constructed by GRANTEE, on the above described land.

The consideration hereinabove recited shall constitute payment in full for any damages to the land of the GRANTOR, his successors and assigns, by reason of the installation, operation, and maintenance of the structures or improvements referred to herein. The GRANTEE covenants to maintain the easement in good repair so that no unreasonable damage will result from its use to the adjacent land of the GRANTOR, his successors and assigns. land of the GRANTOR, his successors and assigns.

The grant and other provisions of this easement shall constitute a covenant running with the land for the benefit of the GRANTEE, its successors and assigns.
