AN ORDINANCE CREATING PAVING DISTRICT NO. 484 OF THE CITY OF FREMONT, NEBRASKA AND ORDERING THE CONSTRUCTION OF STREET IMPROVEMENTS THEREIN; PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION OF NOTICE OF THE CREATION OF SAID PAVING DISTRICT; PROVIDING WHEN THIS ORDINANCE WILL BE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FREMONT, NEBRASKA

SECTION 1. That Paving District No. 484 is hereby created and constituted in the CITY OF FREMONT, NEBRASKA.

SECTION 2. That Paving District No. 484 comprises and includes the paving of that portion of WYOMING AVENUE from the south margin of Country Club Estates Addition to the north margin of Jones Street, and all lots and lands lying east of the east margin of Wyoming Avenue to a depth of one-hundred-ten (110) feet back from the margin thereof; and all lots and lands lying west of the west margin of Wyoming Avenue to a depth of two-hundred (200) feet back from the margin thereof. Said district being created for the purpose of paving said street with concrete and installing Storm Sewer Pipe and Inlets.

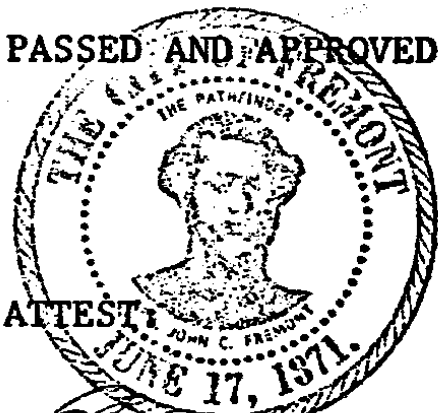
SECTION 3. That authority is granted to assess the entire cost of said improvement exclusive of intersections and spaces opposite alleys against the property benefited within the margins of said proposed paving district.

SECTION 4. If the owners of record title representing a majority of the front footage in a district whose property abuts or adjoins one continuous or extended thoroughfare or more, as aforesaid and who are such owners at the time the ordinance creating the district is published, shall file with the City Clerk within twenty (20) days from the first publication of said notice, written objections to the paving of a district, said work shall not be done in said district under said ordinance, but said ordinance shall be repealed. If objections are not filed against any district in the time and manner aforesaid, the Mayor and Council shall forthwith proceed to construct such paving.

SECTION 5. Notice of the creation of said district shall be published as provided by law in the Fremont Tribune, a legal newspaper published and of general circulation in the City of Fremont, Nebraska and in addition by certified mail, return receipt requested, by sending copies to all owners of property in said district. It is further ordered that this ordinance be filed in the office of the Register of Deeds, Dodge County, Nebraska upon approval and passage according to law.
