Know all men by these presents, that:

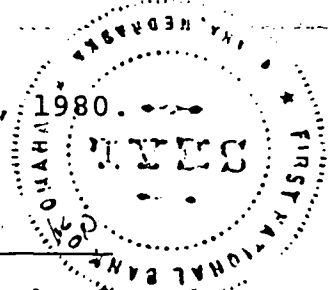

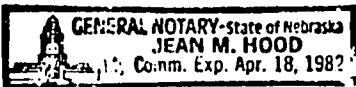
