

CATHODIC UNIT PERMIT

For and in consideration of the sum of Thirty Two and 50/100 Dollars cash to me in hand truly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the undersigned does hereby grant and convey to Socony-Vacuum Oil Company, Incorporated, its successors or assigns, the Right of Way to clear timber, trim necessary trees for and build, maintain, alter, repair, operate and remove poles, wires and appurtenances over and across the following described land situated in Douglas County, State of Nebraska, to-wit:

Northeast Quarter of Section 31, Township 16 North, Range 12 East, with the right of ingress and egress to and from same. The said Grantor, its heirs or assigns to fully use and enjoy the said premises except for the purposes hereinbefore granted to said Grantee, its successors or assigns, who hereby agree to pay any damage that may arise to crops, fences, stock, buildings and land from the building, maintaining, operating and removing of said poles, wires and appurtenances; said damage if not mutually agreed upon to be ascertained and determined by three disinterested persons, one thereof to be appointed by the said grantors, their heirs or assigns, one by said grantee, it's successors or assigns, and the third by the two appointed aforesaid and the award of three such persons shall be final and conclusive.

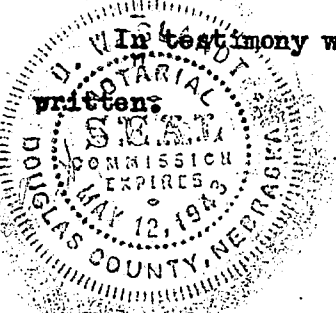
