Said lots to be used for residence purposes only until January 1, 1930, and no structure except an open porch or terrace to be built within thirty feet (30) of the front lot on 32d Avenue nor any dwelling house costing less than Twenty-five Hundred Dollars (\$2500.00)

together with all the tenements, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging, and all the estate, title, dower right of homestead claim or demand whatsoever of the said William A. Redick and Mary W. Redick,

that we have good right and lawful authority to sell

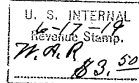
the same and that we will and our heirs, executors, and administrators shall warrant and defend the same unto the said Clarence E. Cunningham
