Mary E. West, being first duly sworn, deposes and syas that she had resided in Papillion, Nebraska for the past 77 years, and during this time she was well and personally acquainted with Dr. Jacob C. Klingeman to whom on or about May 1, 1901, James R. Wilson and Anna H., his wife, conveyed Lot 6, and the South 1/3 of Lot 7, in Block 12, and other lots, in Papillion, Nebraska, and with Mary Klingeman, wife of Dr. Jacob C. Klingeman.
