We, the undersigned residents and freeholders of Douglas County, Nebraska, heretofore selected by said Judge, and being summoned by the Sheriff of said County, and duly qualified to inspect the real estate in said County over and through which the Nebraska Power Company, a corporation, desires to locate and place an electric pole line and to assess the damage which the respective owners of said real estate may sustain, and all persons having any interest or claim whatsoever in said real estate by reason of the appropriation of their land and the granting of an easement upon their land respectively for that purpose in said County, Court, pursuant to notice on the 27 day of March 1928, personally and in a body, actually viewed and inspected the following real estate, situated in Douglas County, Nebraska, through and over which land said Nebraska Power Company has located its electric pole line, and we assessed the damages sustained by the owners of and parties claiming interest in and to said land by reason

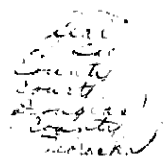

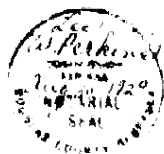
C. A. Larson being duly sworn on oath states
