VILLAGE OF LA VISTA, NEBRASKA ORDINANCE NO. 25

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE VACATION OF ALL OF MARK AVENUE LYING SOUTHWESTERLY OF EASY STREET SOUTH IN THE VILLAGE OF LA VISTA, NEBRASKA; TO PROVIDE THAT SAID VACATED STREET SHALL REVERT TO THE OWNERS OF THE ADJACENT REAL ESTATE, ONE-HALF ON EACH SIDE THEREOF; TO ASCERTAIN ALL DAMAGES SUSTAINED BY THE CITIZENS OF THE VILLAGE OF LA VISTA OR BY THE OWNERS OF THE PROPERTY THEREIN

BE IT ORDAINED by the Chairman and Board of Trustees of the Village of La Vista, Nebraska that all of Mark Avenue lying Southwesterly of Easy Street South in the Village of La Vista should be and hereby is vacated and said vacated Mark Avenue shall revert to the owners of the adjacent real estate, one-half on each side thereof; that this ordinance has been passed for the public good of all citizens and property owners in the Village of La Vista, and the owner of all of the adjacent property has heretofore filed a petition for such vacation and a waiver of all damages on account of such vacation; that consequently the Chairman and Board of Trustees do hereby ascertain that said vacation has resulted and will result in no damages whatever to the citizens of the Village of La Vista or to the owners of property therein.

This ordinance shall become effective upon its passage and publication or posting, as provided by law.

Adopted this 14 day of Artificial, 1962 by a vote of more than three-fourths of the Board of Trustees of said Village after having dispensed with the rule by said three-fourths vote for the reading of all ordinances on three different days. Thereupon, said ordinance, with the yeas and mays called and recorded, was read by title one time when introduced, and was read by title a second time after the rule was dispensed with, and was then read at large and put upon final passage and vote, at which time adoption of the ordinance was voted as follows:
