

AN ORDINANCE

Vacating a portion of the alley space in block 12 of Cahn, Metcalf & Farwell's Addition to the City of Lincoln, and providing that said property shall revert to and become a part of the lots adjoining thereon, and repealing all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LINCOLN:

Section 1. That a space sixteen feet in width and one hundred feet in length, extending from the west line of Fifth Street to the west line of lot 2 in block 12 of said Cahn, Metcalf & Farwell's Addition to the City of Lincoln, being the east one hundred feet of the alley in said block, and the same is hereby vacated.

Section 2. That said space shall revert to and become part of the lots adjoining thereon.

Section 3. That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.

~~This ordinance shall take effect and be in force~~

Section 4. This vacation is made in consideration and on the condition that the School district of the city of Lincoln shall grant a perpetual public right of way over and along the west side of lot 25 of said block 12, Cahn, Metcalf & Farwell's Addition, of equal width to the alley hereby vacated, extending ~~in xxxxx xxxxxx~~ <sup>South</sup> North to Charleston Street.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.


