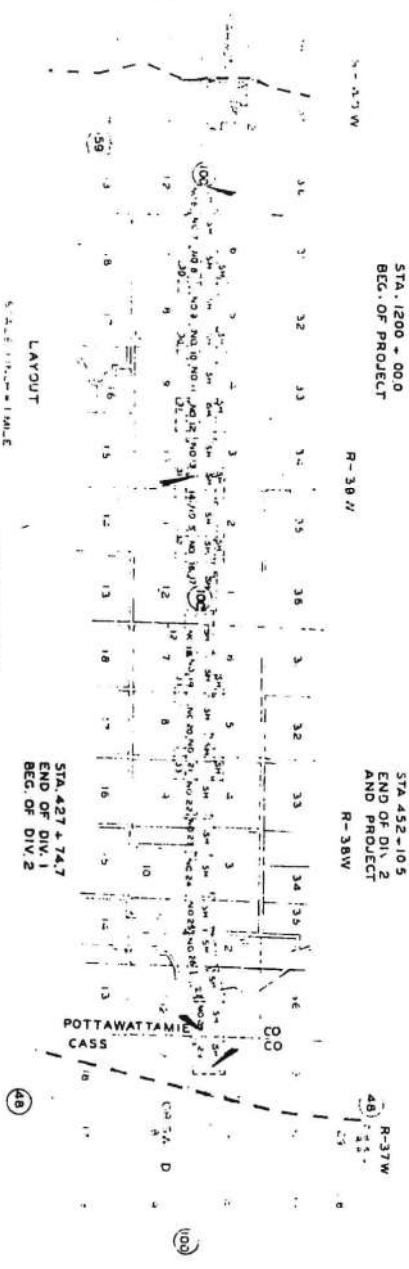
Beginning at Sta. 1200 + 00 (Equation: 1421 + 81.7

BE IT RESOLVED by the Iowa State Highway Commission:

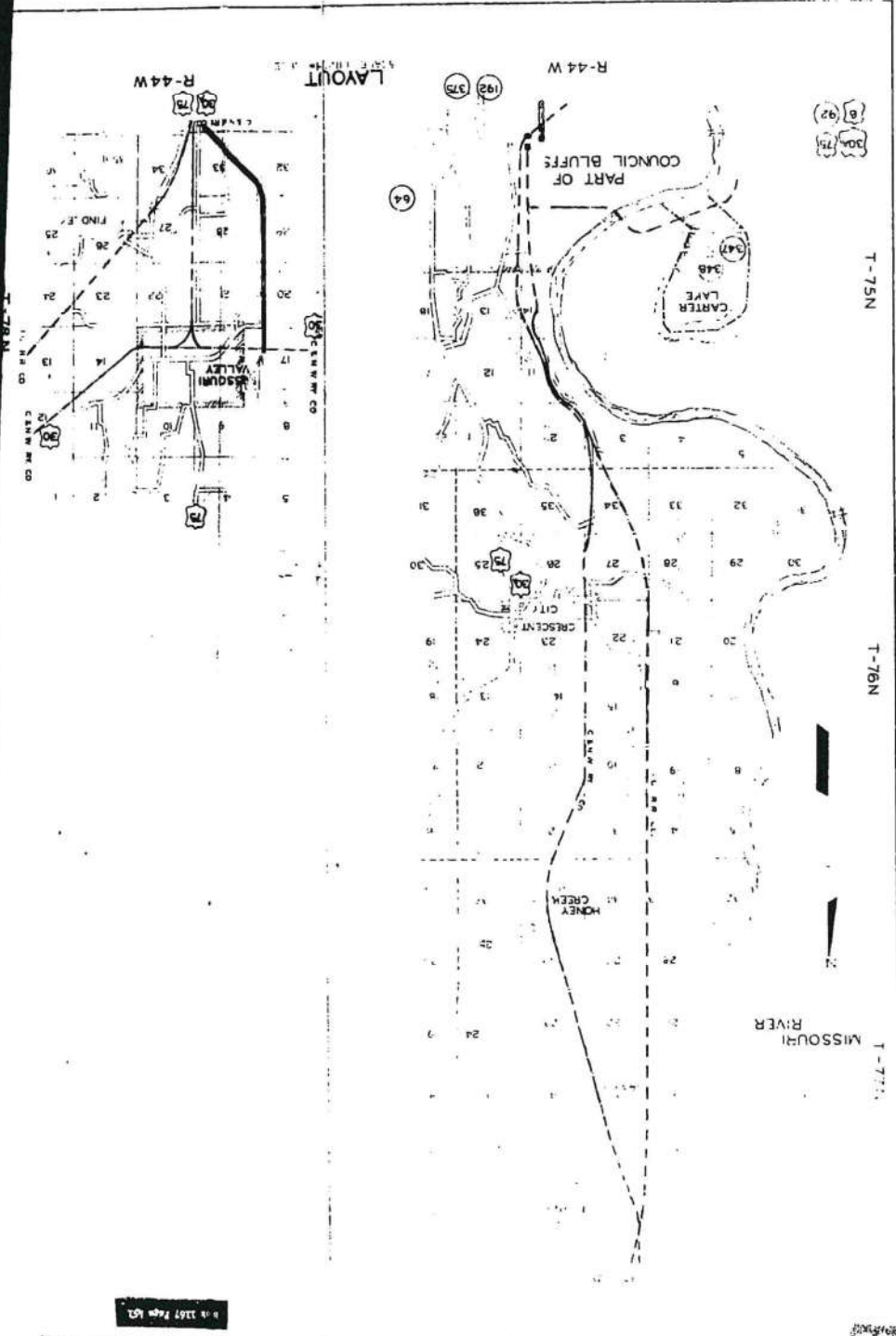

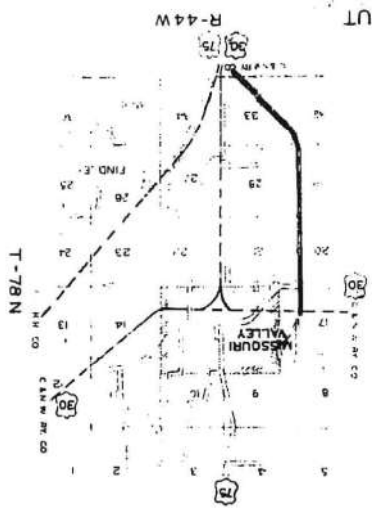
