and to hear all persons interested therein with reference to the portions of said lands to be condemned, appropriated, taken and damaged by the OMAHA PUBLIC POWER DISTRICT, of Omaha, Nebraska, and with reference to the damages which the owners and other persons in interest, have sustained by reason of the construction of a transmission line across said lands; and to assess the damages which the owners, and other persons interested in said lands have sustained by reason thereof.
