ordinance no. 1006

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE NECESSITY, EXPEDIENCY AND PROPRIETY OF VACATING LOIS AVENUE IN THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, SARPY COUNTY, NEBRASKA, FROM THE INTERSECTION OF LOIS AVENUE AND BELLEVUE BOULEVARD NORTHWESTERLY TO A POINT WHERE LOIS AVENUE TERMINATES AT THE NORTHWESTERLY CORNER OF LOT 29 IN JEWELL PLACE, IN THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, NOT HERETOFORE VACATED; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND ALL PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH AND DESIGNATING EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Bellevue, Nebraska, has determined that no damages will accrue to any citizens of the City of Bellevue, nor to any owners of property herein by reason of the proposed vacation.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. It is hereby necessary, expedient and proper to vacate all of Lois Avenue in the City of Bellevue, Sarpy County, Nebraska, from the intersection of Lois Avenue and Bellevue Boulevard, Northwesterly to a point where Lois Avenue terminates at the Northwesterly corner of Lot 29 in Jewell Place, in the City of Bellevue, not heretofore vacated, and the same be and hereby is vacated.

Section 2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective after its passage, approval and publication according to law.
