

EASEMENT

The undersigned grantor in consideration of the payment of Forty Five Dollars (\$ 45.00), receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hereby grants unto the City of Blair, Nebraska, its successors and assigns, a perpetual easement to survey, construct, reconstruct, operate and maintain its high voltage electric transmission lines, with all poles, towers, cross-arms, cables, wires, guys, supports and other fixtures and appliances, over, upon, along and above the following described real estate:

A strip of land twenty feet in width, North of and adjacent to the South line of Tax Lot 28, Section 2, Township 18 North, Range 11, East of the 6th P. M., in Washington County, Nebraska.

The undersigned grantor hereby grants to said City, its successors and assigns the right, privilege and authority to enter upon and pass over said property and the property of the grantor adjacent thereto for the purpose of surveying, constructing, repairing, operating, and maintaining said lines and equipment including the right and authority to cut down or trim any trees or limbs of trees on either side thereof which might be a hazard to said transmission lines.

Grantor reserves the right to cultivate, use and occupy said land, except that he shall not erect any structures, hay or straw stacks or other objects within 20 feet on either side of the center line. The City shall at all times exercise due care and diligence to avoid injury to crops, livestock or other personal property of the grantor, and said City agrees to promptly pay grantor or for any crop damage which it may cause in the construction, operation and maintenance of said electric transmission lines.

This easement is binding upon the heirs, executors, administrators and assigns of the grantor.
